


The Linden Times

The Calvert County Historical Society is very proud and happy to share with our members and friends the great successes we have had hosting some wonderful events at Linden this year. Beginning in June was the first of four of our free **Outdoor "Front Porch" Summer Concert Series** which ended in October. These last few months of 2021 have seen our **Fall "Grand Parents Day" Tea** which was attended by members and their guest with seating both inside Linden and on the front porch. Next was our **CCHS Annual Membership Dinner and Silent Auction**, at Jefferson Patterson Park and Museum. This outdoor event was attended by many folks who thoroughly enjoyed the festivities, the Silent Auction and our guest speaker, Carol Booker who talked about her new book, **Cove Point**. Fall rang in a very successful **Barns of Calvert County Art Show & Sale** by local artists featuring the disappearing barns of Calvert County.

The *Hospice Annual Festival of Wreaths*, was held at Linden on November 20th. The money raised at this event went to Hospice to support the great work they do for people and families in our community. The most recent event just completed was the *December 4th Home for the Holidays – Light Up Linden*. This event was held in partnership with The Calvert County Chamber of Commerce. The highlight of the event was caroling, visits by Santa and the Grinch, and the lighting of the Linden

The CCHS shifted many events and programs to late summer and fall and began this very publication, *The Linden Times* to keep in constant contact with our membership by providing historic Calvert County stories, articles and news on a bi-weekly basis. 


